

Josh Groban's Find Your Light Foundation Donates \$1.5 Million Toward Arts Education Programs



March 31, 2026 (Los Angeles, CA) – The Find Your Light Foundation (FYLF), founded by global superstar Josh Groban, announced that in its most recent grant cycle it awarded over \$1.5 Million to 257 nonprofit organizations in 40 states. This grantmaking will help ensure access to high quality arts education for over 600,000 K-12 youth.

The [full list of Grantees](#) includes organizations working with youth in theatre, dance, music, photography, visual art, and creative writing. Grants are selected through a competitive review process, and funding comes from the Groban family and supporters of FYLF from across the nation.

FYLF Founder and Board Member Josh Groban said:

These amazing organizations reflect the incredible work being done by teaching artists and educators everywhere to inspire students to explore their creative talents and dreams – especially in neighborhoods and cities where arts funding doesn’t always reach those students with the greatest need. I’m honored that our Foundation can contribute toward this important goal.”

“This year’s pool of grant recipients was selected from the largest number of applications for support that we’ve ever received. Tony®, EMMY®, and five-time GRAMMY® Award-nominated singer, songwriter, actor, and philanthropist Josh Groban possesses one of the most outstanding and instantly recognizable voices in music. With a career spanning chart-topping albums, global tours, and acclaimed stage and screen performances, he has sold over 35 million albums worldwide and headlined legendary venues across multiple continents. His catalog spans a series of chart-topping blockbuster albums, including *Josh Groban* (5x-platinum), *Closer* (6x-platinum), *Noël* (7x-platinum), *Awake* (2x-platinum), *Illuminations*, *All That Echoes*, *Stages* (his first UK #1 album), *Bridges*, *Harmony* and *Gems*. A dynamic presence on Broadway, Groban earned Tony® nominations for his roles in *Natasha, Pierre & The Great Comet of 1812* and the 2023 revival of *Sweeney Todd*, which also garnered him a GRAMMY® nomination and widespread critical acclaim. His versatility extends to film and television appearances ranging from *Glee* and *The Office* to *Crazy, Stupid, Love* and Netflix's *The Good Cop*, as well as starring as the Beast in ABC's *Beauty and the Beast: A 30th Celebration*. Beyond performance, Groban remains an active arts education philanthropist and advocate, and his Find Your Light Foundation helps enrich the lives of young students through arts, education, and cultural awareness.

This year, Groban will release his new album *CINEMATIC*, arriving May 8 via Reprise Records. Produced by Greg Wells and recorded in Los Angeles and London, the 10-track collection pays tribute to iconic songs from beloved films including *The Godfather*, *Casablanca*, *Breakfast at Tiffany's*, and *Stand By Me*. Groban recently launched his *GEMS World Tour* with sold-out performances across Asia and Australia before continuing through Europe this spring. Josh will also tour North America this summer, where he will be joined by special guest Jennifer Hudson. In the fall he will return to The Colosseum at Caesars Palace for *Josh Groban: GEMS – The Las Vegas Residency*. With new music and performances throughout the year, Groban continues to connect with audiences through his unmistakable voice and timeless repertoire.
